It is called 'Flaming June' and was painted by Sir Frederic Leighton in 1895. The color orange is the most prominent color we see, it represents youth, energy & sensuality.

It was actually plastered over during a renovation in the early 1900's and uncovered by carpenters as they worked in 1960, ending up in a little art store in London.

It has a fun story: Andrew Lloyd Webber wanted his family to purchase it years ago before he became wealthy; he asked his grandmother for money to purchase the painting; she responded that she 'did not want that piece of Victorian junk in her flat'. This painting, years later, set an Auction record bringing the highest

amount for a piece of artwork sold during that year.
